PUBLIC NOTICE

It is hereby notified for general information of all concerned that the Election Commission of India has launched the "Electors Verification Programme" from 1st September 2019 to 15th October, 2019. The objectives of the Electors Verification Programme are:-

- i. To verify elector's details and indicate corrections in details, if any, including photograph and authentication of entry.
- ii. To obtain details of family members and verifying their entries, removal of entries of shifted and dead electors, enrolment of unenrolled citizens and to obtain details of prospective electors in the family.
- iii. To obtain contact details/GIS Coordinates (with Smart Phone) to provide better Electoral Services.
- iv. To obtain inputs about existing/probable Polling Stations.
- v. To improve health of electoral roll by removal of DSEs and Logical Errors.
- vi. To improve delivery of electoral services.

2. Electors may verify their details through:-

- i. "Voter helpline" Mobile app (which can be downloaded from Google Playstore)
- ii. NVSP Portal (www.nvsp.in)
- iii. By visiting Common Service Centres (CSCs)
- iv. By visiting Voter Facilitation Centres (VFCs) at ERO/AERO office.
- v. PwD electors may call Voter helpline (1950) seeking facilitation.

3. Authentication of entry can be done by furnishing copy of one of the following documents:-

- i. Indian Passport
- ii. Driving License
- iii. Aadhar
- iv. Ration Card
- v. Identity Card for Government/semi Government Officials
- vi. Bank Passbooks
- vii. Farmer's Identity Card
- viii. PAN Card
- ix. Smart Card issued by RGI under NPR
- x. Latest water/telephone/electricity/gas connection bill for that address either in the name of the applicant or that of his/her immediate relation like parents etc.
- xi. Any other document as approved by the Commission.
